## REPORT THROUGH FEBRUARY 28, 2023 - 67% THROUGH THE FISCAL YEAR

- Total Job Seekers Served = FY23 YTD 4037.
- Dislocated Workers Enrolled 81% of goal.
- Adult Enter Employments –125; 51% of yearly goal.
- Adult Wages ahead of goal; \$24.11 (148%); and Dislocated Worker Wages ahead of goal; \$25.56 (128%). The MassHireGBCC is working with MassHireGBWB with the CDL program.
- Dislocated Workers Employments 36; 51% of yearly goal.
- o Mr. Murray gave two (2) Success Stories of people facing hard obstacles in hiring issues but ultimately finding work against all odds one: Domestic program/gets CDL license in a tough situation [referral from DTA]; and two: customer lost job, pregnant and ultimately obtaining employment despite a tough situation. Mr. Murray also talked about the different issues of customers coming the MassHireGBCC doors.
