The Machine Technology/Advanced Manufacturing program provides instruction in: Basic Machining Principles, Advanced Machining Principles, Mastercam CAD/CAM part design, part posting and downloading to CNC equipment, as well as hand sketching and basic blueprints.

Students are trained to:

- Design tolerances of +/- .003. (3/1000th of an inch)
- Use a variety of precision instruments: micrometers, dial, digital and Vernier calipers, and dial indicators
