  - Mr. Craig Kennedy presented FY2023 budget to date (for November 2022
    - FY2022 carry-in for adults almost spent. Still working on the carry-in for Wagner-Peyser \$13,000 remaining and Dislocated Worker \$23,000 remains.
    - Mass Commission for the Blind, Mass Rehab, ACLs spending at low pace; MassHireGBCC still waiting for final figures.
    - New Hires: The new Upskilling Navigator person has been hired at the MassHireGBCC. There are no staff openings to date.
    - Training: remaining dollars Dislocated Worker \$\$30,000 and Adults \$71,000.

    - Expenditures at 39% expended to date. (Includes salary & fringe up to November).
    - WIOA Youth at 38% expended \$306,183.

    - Shannon Grant closed.
    - Behavior Health ends December 30, 2022.
