
MassHire's MOVE Maker

...a mobile training lab!



With a generous donation from Brockton Area Transit (BAT), MassHire GBWB will soon be able to offer local employers & organizations a clean, comfortable, mobile training site inside of a renovated 25-foot bus containing 9 work-stations with computers and internet and room for an instructor. The bus is equipped with a wheelchair lift and has a handicapped accessible work station. This mobile learning lab will provide a dedicated space in which groups of employees may receive training on a variety of job-related topics such as: ESOL, Microsoft Office, customer service, leadership, etc. Being mobile and self-contained, this training incubator can be parked conveniently on company property and enhances the ability for a company to easily provide training to strengthen the skills of its workers.


